Youth Certificate

- Deposit \$25 into a Pennie Kids or CU Succeed Savings Account and then the Credit Union will open a Youth Certificate starting with the \$25 deposit.
- For every marking period, the child can submit their report card grades to earn \$5 for every "A" and \$3 for every "B" they receive up to \$20 per grading period. All grades/report cards must be submitted within 30 days from the end of the grading period and is for CORE Curriculum only.
- Grades can be submitted via email to pseyouthcd@psecuorg.net or brought into any of our office locations for submission.
- The CD matures and is deposited into the student's savings account by their 19th birthday (after their final deposit when they can produce a diploma or GED.)
